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Assessment of clinical efficacy of *Vaman Karma* followed by *Virechan* and *Basti Karma* in the management of *Dadru* w. s. r. to *Dermatophytosis*. Borase Snehal Vijay^{*1}, Kulkarni Savita A.²

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ABSTRACT:

Dadru is described in Kshudra *kushtha* by acharya Charak. The symptoms like Kandu (Itching), Raga (Erythema), (Exanthemas) and Mandala Pidaka (Discoid lesions with elevated borders) seen in Dadru is analogous to the symptoms of Dermatophytosis. Most of skin infections caused by dermatophytes are referred as tinea and often severe as well as recurrent. Ringworm infections are also called as dermatophytosis which is characterized by the infection of keratinized tissues like epidermis, hair and nails. In modern science, tropical antifungal drugs, oral anti-fungal drugs are used to treat ring worms at various stages. Nowadays resistance is increasing to antifungal allopathic drugs. So, there is a need to study and research the effective, safe and affordable Ayurvedic treatment for the management of Dadru So, I decided to work on this topic.

Kapha and pitta doshas are predominant in Dadru. As Dadru is type of kshudra kushta, shodhan therapy must be primary treatment for elimination of vitiated doshas. So panchakarma therapies like Vaman, Virechana and Basti given to the patient as stated in ayurvedic classics. Total effect of *Vaman* therapy was 29.19 %, Total effect of *Vaman* followed by *Virechana* therapy was 58.66 %, Total effect of *Vaman* followed by *Virechana* and *Basti* therapy was 77.58 %. Hence, we can conclude that *shodhan* therapy effective in management of *Dadru* but it needs frequent *shodhana* for total eradication of disease according to *bala* of patient.

Skin is the largest organ of human body. Its size and external location makes it susceptible to a wide variety of disorders. In recent years there has been a considerable increase in the incidents of skin problems in the tropical and developing countries like India due to reasons like poverty, various poor sanitation, unhygienic conditions, frequent use of tight cloths, pollution. I have found that there are more patients with Dermatophytosis than any other skin diseases.

Dadru is *Kapha pittaja* disorder which is explained on Brihatrayi and

Laghutrayi which comes under *Kshudra Kushta* characterized by following symptoms-

Tropical anti-fungal drugs, oral anti-fungal drugs are used to treat ring worms at various stages in modern medical science. Nowadays resistance is increasing to anti-fungal allopathic drugs so, it is essential to find out better remedy for this condition. *Panchakarma* is specialty of ayurveda, in which vitiated doshas removed from human body and cure disease from its root. *Shodhana* therapy is the best treatment for *dadru* so, we decided to give *Vaman karma* followed by *Virechana karma* and *Basti karma*.

Aims And Objects:

<u>Aim:</u>

Assessment of clinical efficacy of *Vamana* followed by *virechan* and *basti karma* in management of *dadru*.

Objectives:

- 1. To study the ayurvedic literature of *Dadru*.
- 2. To study modern literature of Dermatophytosis.
- 3. To study the effect of *Vamana* followed by *virechan and basti karma in* relieving sign and symptoms of *Dadru*.

MATERIALS AND METHODS

Selection of Patients and study duration: In the present study 10 patients showing symptoms of *Dadru* of different age group are selected at OPD of Arogya Shala Rugnalaya, Nashik and the study was carried out for total duration of 5 months.

A. Diagnostic Criteria:

Diagnosis of *Dadru* was made according to the signs and symptoms mentioned in classical *Ayurvedic* text and contemporary medical book.

B. Inclusion Criteria:

1) Patients with classical signs and symptoms of *Dadru* like *Kandu* (Itching), *Rag* (Redness), *Pidaka* (Papules/Elevation of skin), *Mandal* (Rings).

3) Eligible for Vaman, Virechana and Basti.

4) Patients of age group between 20-60 years irrespective of sex.

C. Exclusion Criteria:

Patients with uncontrolled systemic disorders like DM/HTN/Cardiac disorders/ Psoriasis/ Leprosy/ Tuberculosis/ Malignancy/severe anemia etc. were excluded.

Treatment details-<u>1.Vamana Karma:</u>

Procedure **Drug and Dose** Duration Snehapana Tikta ghrita Till samyaka snigdha lakshanas are seen in vardhaman matra starting from 30 ml (upto maximum 7 days) Sarvanga Tila Taila 2 days Snehana Sarvanga Bashpa sweda 2 days Sweadana Vamana Vamana Kalpa-Madanphala churna -On vaman day 4-5 gm, pippali churna-2 gm, vacha churna – 1 gm, saindhava 2 gm,

Dipan, pachan chikitsa given to the patient before starting snehapan.

This study was done on 10 patients of Panchakarma department; The observation is as below:

DISCUSSION:

In the present study, an attempt has been made to study the effect of *Vamana* followed by *Virechan and Basti* in 10 patients suffering with *Dadru* disease with symptoms like *Kandu, Raga, Pidaka, Mandala* etc. *Shodhana* therapy creates unfavorable atmosphere for dermatophytosis causing organism, also improves strength of dhatus So, further disease progress does not occur.

After *Vaman karma*, percentage relief in *kandu* was 42.86%, relief in *raga* (Redness) was 28 %, relief in *pidaka* was 26.67%, relief in *mandala* was 19.23%. Total % relief in all symptoms was 29.19%. After *Virechan karma*, percentage relief in *kandu* was 82.86 %, relief in *raga* (Redness) was 60.00%, relief in *pidaka* was 53.33%, relief in *mandala* was 38.46%. Total % relief in all symptoms was 58.66%.

After *Basti karma*, percentage relief in *kandu* was 94.29 %, relief in *raga* (Redness) was 84.00%, relief in *pidaka* was 66.67%, relief in *mandala* was 65.38%. Total % relief in all symptoms was 77.58%.

After a proper schedule of *Vamana* followed by *Virechan* and *Basti Kandu* and *Raga* showed moderate to complete relief. The parameters like number of *Mandala*, size of *Mandala*, *Pidaka* showed statistically low significant results.

CONCLUSION:

Although, the Vamana is considered the prime treatment modality for Kapha Dosha. Vamana drug is having Ushna, Tikshna, Aashukari, Vyavayi, Vikasi properties helps in elimination of Doshas. In this process Doshas in Kostha eliminated from the body by the act of vomiting. Virechana karma is also main treatment for pitta dosha. At last basti given which contains selected dravyas from kushtaghna and kandughna gana.

On the basis of clinical study, we can conclude that *Vamana* followed by *virechan and basti is* effective in relieving the signs and symptoms of *Dadru* with special reference to dermatophytosis. As

kushtha is *bahudosh prakopaka vyadhi* so frequent *shodhan* according to *bala* of patient is essential.

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
